Knots is inspired by a throat singing technique originated from the northern part of Romania (Maramureş), a subgenre of the "Doină" called "Horea cu noduri", which translates roughly to "singing in knots". This piece is a third attempt to transpose into contemporary music this Romanian traditional technique that is slowly disappearing due to its complexity and to its demandingness on singers' voices. Although it significantly resembles the well-known yodeling technique, its aesthetics and meaning are quite opposite, as the Romanian traditional singing technique is rather used in sad songs.

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
